ATTENTION 7th GRADE PARENTS

It is now a Missouri state requirement for any student entering 8th grade to have a **Meningococcal Conjugate** vaccination *and* a **TDAP** booster shot. If your child has received this shot, you need to provide an updated immunization record to the clinic. Students should have the Meningococcal Conjugate vaccine and TDAP booster shot before the start of the 2017-2018 school year.
