If your child has received this shot, you need to provide an updated immunization record to the clinic. Students should have the Meningococcal Conjugate vaccine and TDAP booster shot before the start of the 2018-2019 school year. If making doctor's appointments, shot records may be faxed directly to the clinic at 636-272-6361 or a copy may be dropped off at school.
